- Call to Order
  - o Chair Fitch called the meeting to order at 9:02 am
- Roll Call / Attendance
  - Lindsey Dyer conducted attendance:
    - 12/13 voting SERC members present (not present: President Robert 'Deuce' Larsen)
    - 3/4 ex officio SERC members present (not present: Senator Steve Drazkowski)
- Adoption of Agenda
  - o Motion to approve the agenda was made by Whitworth; seconded by McKenzie
  - No discussion; agenda was approved
- Updates from Chair/Vice Chair
  - Chair Fitch shared that approximately 2,600 entries were received (85% flags and 15% seals) and expressed gratitude for all who have participated:
    - "Thank you, Minnesota! Your entries are creative, vibrant, colorful, and show the many attributes of our amazing state. You have given us a great starting point as we embark on the next phase of our process. Thank you for all of the work that you have put into your submissions!!"
  - MNHS shared a series of seals that represent the various city, county, and tribal governments, and other agencies in Minnesota; document will be shared with the Commission as a reference for the seal design process
  - MNHS shared an update on the SERC budget (\$35,000)
    - A good portion of the budget is directed toward staffing costs
    - There will be limited funds available for printing and further administrative costs
- Update on submissions and PR/media
  - MNHS shared that there were several last-minute interview requests; there was a good amount of media coverage in the final rush
  - Chair Fitch and Vice Chair Gaul were thanked for their interviews in the final days before submission closed
- Timeline for selection process
  - Review and approval of updated DRAFT SERC Meeting and Process Timeline (attachment)

- Chair Fitch shared an updated DRAFT of the timeline, highlighting the public input process updates
- Commission members were overall in favor of the updated timeline; there was discussion to clarify that submission names were not used (only specific identifying numbers) and to clarify that the Commission would receive the statements that related to the submissions
- Motion to approve the timeline was made by Mazone; seconded by Jackson
- No discussion; timeline was approved
- Specialist testimony (TBD)
  - Ted Kaye from the North American Vexillological Association (NAVA) joined as a specialist to present an overview of how to choose a flag design and offer tangible considerations during the selection process
  - Kaye's presentation slides (available on the <u>SERC website</u>) was a basic primer on flag design and focused on themes of simplicity and recognizability
  - Commission members followed with a brief discussion about the presentation
    - There was a question about color-blind considerations for shades and designs
