- Roll Call / Attendance

- Adoption of Agenda
 - Motion to approve the agenda was made by Wittnebel; seconded by Harralson
 - No discussion; agenda was approved
- Updates from Chair/Vice Chair
 - Chair Fitch thanked the Commission for the hard work at the 11/21 in person meeting
- Update on PR/media
 - MNHS shared an update on media coverage, which has been extensive
- Update on public input
 - MNHS shared that the <u>SERC website</u> was open for public comment around the same time as when the finalist designs were posted; over two thousand comments have come in, to date
- Flag and Seal designs: review and next steps
 - Chair Fitch delivered a presentation that captured the overall conversations and questions that have been addressed since the finalists have been announced; full presentation is available on the <u>SERC website</u>
 - Commission members discussed various public input/feedback that they received thus far. Comments ranged from positive to negative; the Commission addressed the potential relatability of the flag designs and expressed a mixed reaction from the public re: the symbols, colors, and representation in flag designs
 - Commission members expressed an interest in winnowing the design selections in order to focus design efforts on a few designs; there was general agreement to continue receiving public input prior to winnowing with an emphasis that the finalists are drafts and subject to modification

- Wittnebel presented a variety of proposed design changes with variations to the flag design submissions; these were created in collaboration with various members of the public interested in flag and seal design
